APT Bargaining Update

The Bargaining Team met with the District on April 7, 2022.

Payment for retro (on schedule/off schedule increases)

The school board voted unanimously to ratify the tentative agreement. The district provided information from Sandra Garcia, Chief Business Officer (CBO), regarding timelines for payments to our members. She will provide the timelines when she returns to the office next week.

COVID Sick Leave (October-December 2021)

The district proposed to cabinet the reimbursement of sick time to members who were out during October 1-December 17, 2021 due to COVID. The cabinet declined any sort of reimbursement at this time.

Short Term Independent Study

The district presented information on the number of students absent during the month of January during the COVID surge. The number of students absent were more than the number of students who participated in short-term independent study. The district is still looking into providing payment to teachers for the month of January who provided work to students for short-term independent study.

2022-2023 School Calendar

The bargaining team was provided a proposed calendar from the district and the calendar committee for our review. More details will be forthcoming.

Summer Professional Learning Opportunities

The bargaining team proposed increasing the hourly rate from \$25 dollars an hour to \$40 dollars an hour. The district accepted our proposed offer for the 2021-2022 school year.

Late Start time for the High Schools (SB328)

The District announced they would be meeting with the high school committee representatives regarding the late start time that will begin in August 2022.

MOU Mt. SAC (Appendix XVIII)

The bargaining team and the district agreed to extend the MOU until June 30, 2023 depending on the funding from Mt. SAC.

The next bargaining dates are April 14, 25, and 29.
