- 1. Meeting called to order at 4:20 p.m. Introduction was made to the CTA Intervention Team members. Meeting norms were reviewed.

- 4. Macleod made motion to approve minutes from 5-2-22 and Jimenez-Mireles seconded. Minutes were approved without objections.
- 5. President's Report:
  - 75 new teachers attended the New Teacher Orientation
  - Administrators were asked to meet with site reps monthly and to provide 10 minutes to site reps during staff meetings
  - New members on executive board were introduced
  - APT committee chairs and members were appointed and approved by the Executive Board
  - Pomona Host Lions Charities offers mini grants to all classroom teachers
  - Consult APT website for calendar, events, and other information
  - Invitation to attend CTA conferences and information on reimbursement for conferences

  - Presented financial documents (profit & loss, reconciliation, check registers)
  - Overall increase in monthly dues by \$0.70(CTA & NEA but not local dues)
  - Financial audit findings for 2021 fiscal year showed overall improved accounting of expenses but the Association has encumbrance of over \$1 million due to various pending litigations

- J. Bargaining District offered 5% on schedule and \$50 a month; Demand to Bargain was requested as there are additional \$23 million coming to the District; two bargaining dates were scheduled but canceled by the District
